Reagent Codes

If you feel that you've been poisoned by any of the reagents in the kits, you should immediately call poison control or Hach. All LaMotte reagents are registered with Poison Control, but Hach can help you more if poisoned by one of their reagents. Luckily, we're only using one Hach kit and it only has one reagent. The Hach number is (303) – 623-5716. It is a 24 hour line.

The code numbers of the LaMotte reagents can be found on the top left side of the containers. If you cannot find them, here is a list:

Dissolved Oxygen

- Sodium Thiosulfate – 4169
- Alk Pot Iodide Azide – 7166
- Sulfamic Acid – 6286
- Starch Indicator – 4170
- Manganous Sulfate – 4167

Nitrate-Nitrogen
